APPROPRIATION TRANSFER RESOLUTION

101 GENERAL

WHEREAS, certain fiscal demands have developed since the adoption of the current Civil City annual budget so that it is now necessary to transfer appropriation authority within a fund without increasing or decreasing the overall appropriation authority.

WHEREAS, the City must now cover an unplanned and unbudgeted cost for the demolition and clean-up of an abandoned structure located at 19570 Forsythe Drive.

WHEREAS, \$769,500 was previously appropriated from the General Fund to Non-Departmental for 2018, as part of the 2018 annual budget ordinance, to establish a contingency reserve for non-personnel uses which may be transferred to augment the 2018 budget of any City department to cover an unplanned and unbudgeted cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, to address such demands for the General Fund:

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Noblesville, Indiana, that, for the obligations of the Civil City, the following appropriation increases be executed:
