AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 64-8-05 THE CHAPEL WOODS PLANNED DEVELOPMENT AND THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, A PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF NOBLESVILLE, HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA

This is an ordinance (the "PUD Ordinance") to amend Ordinance No. the Chapel Woods Planned Development, the Unified Development Ordinance for the City of Noblesville, Hamilton county, Indiana (the "City's Development ordinance"), enacted by the City of Noblesville under authority of chapter 174 of the Acts of the Indiana General Assembly 1947, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Noblesville has conducted a public hearing on Application 09N-15-0500 as required by law in regard to the application for a change of zone district designation filed by Chapel Woods LLC ("Chapel Woods"); and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission at their October 19, 2009 meeting sent its favorable recommendation to the Noblesville Common council by a vote of 7 in favor and 2 opposed;

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission at their October 19, 2009 meeting recommended favorably subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That, in the event the location of the sign is dedicated as right-of-way, that the sign would be moved to another location on the Real Estate at the petitioners sole expense and will still meet the 10 foot setback requirement.
- 2. That the sign shall not be illuminated.
- 3. That the sign will be permitted to remain on the Real Estate for a period of three (3) years from the date of approval of this ordinance

- regardless of the presence of other development signage for Union Chapel Shoppes.
- 4. That the petitioner has the right to locate any future builders in Chapel Woods on the sign.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, meeting in regular session, that the Unified Development Ordinance for said City and the Official Zone Map of said Ordinance are hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The subject real estate (the "Real Estate"), more particularly described in "Exhibit 1" attached hereto, is located generally 10 feet east of the northeastern corner of Union Chapel Road and Greenfield Avenue, all of which is located within the zoning jurisdiction of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana. The Real Estate hereby shall maintain its existing zoning and the purpose of this ordinance is exclusively for the purpose of amending the signage package for the Chapel Woods development to also allow for the placement of an offsite temporary directional sign.

SECTION 2. The proposed Program for signs attached hereto as "Exhibit 2," is adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Planned Development Ordinance and its Exhibits (collectively, the "PD Sign Standards") permit variations from the development standards, specifications, guidelines and/or requirements (collectively, the "Standards") contained in the City's Development Ordinance. The PD Sign Standards supersede the Standards in the City's Development Ordinance to the extent the PD Sign Standards vary, alter or modify the Standards in the City's Development Ordinance. The Standards in the City's Development ordinance, however, shall apply to the extent that the PD Sign Standards do not vary, alter or modify them.

SECTION 4. Nothing in this ordinance shall limit or interfere with any signage that would otherwise be permitted on the underlying property by the Unified Development Ordinance or any previous or future zoning approvals on the property in the case where the proposed sign was not located on the property.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

SECTION 6. Upon motion duly made and seconded, this Ordinance was fully passed by the members of the Common Council this *[O.kl.]* day of November, 2009.


