## ORDINANCE NO. 6-2-04

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, A PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF NOBLESVILLE, HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA

This is an ordinance (the "PUD Ordinance") to amend the Unified Development Ordinance for the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana (the "City's Development Ordinance"), enacted by the City of Noblesville under authority of Chapter 174 of the Acts of the Indiana General Assembly 1947, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Noblesville has conducted a public hearing on Application 03N-15-2328 as required by law in regard to the application for a change of zone district designation filed by Triton Development, LLC; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission at their February 17, 2004 meeting sent its favorable recommendation to the Noblesville Common Council by a vote of 12 in favor and 0 opposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, meeting in regular session, that the Unified Development Ordinance for said City and the Official Zone Map of said Ordinance are hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The subject real estate (the "Real Estate"), more particularly described in "Exhibit 1" attached hereto, is located generally at the southwest corner of Cherry Tree Road and 171<sup>st</sup> Street, all of which is located within the zoning jurisdiction of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana. The Real Estate hereby is rezoned from the R-2 classification to the

R2/PD Residential Planned Development classification, as designated in the City's Development Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The preliminary development plan attached hereto as "Exhibit 2," the Development Guidelines attached hereto as "Exhibit 3" and the Architectural and Landscaping Guidelines attached hereto as "Exhibit 4" are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Planned Development Ordinance, its exhibits and the preliminary development plan approved by the Plan Commission (collectively, the "PD Standards") permit variations from the development standards, specifications, guidelines and/or requirements (collectively, the "Standards") contained in the City's Development Ordinance. The following variations are included: the preliminary development plan, the Development Guidelines and the Architectural and Landscaping Guidelines. The PD Standards supersede the Standards in the City's Development Ordinance to the extent the PD Standards vary, alter or modify the Standards in the City's Development Ordinance. The Standards in the City's Development Ordinance, however, shall apply to the extent that the PD Standards do not vary, alter or modify them.

SECTION 4. Upon motion duly made and seconded, this Ordinance was fully passed by the members of the Common Council this 23rd day of March, 2004.
