ORDINANCE NO. 7-2-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 28-8-97 AND THE ZONING COMMITMENTS CONCERNING DEVELOPMENT AND USE OF REAL ESTATE IN PRAIRIE LAKES PLANNED DEVELOPMENT IN NOBLESVILLE, HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA

An ordinance to amend the building base landscaping requirements, specifically for Lot 10 and a portion of Lot 11 in Prairie Lakes Planned Development, as evidenced in the Zoning Commitments Concerning the Development and Use of Real Estate (recorded in the Hamilton County Recorder's Office #200300030027) for the construction of a Bank One Branch as enacted by the City of Noblesville under authority of Chapter 174 of the Acts of the Indiana General Assembly 1947, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Noblesville has conducted a public hearing as required by law in regard to the application #04N-15-0009 submitted by Bank One for property located at 14195 Mundy Drive, Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana regarding amending the building base landscaping requirements, specifically for the above noted lots, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has sent to the Common Council its decision of February 17th, 2004 meeting, reflecting a vote of 12 ayes and 0 nays with a favorable recommendation for adoption of the amendment for parcel no. 18-11-19-00-28-010.000 and a portion of parcel no. 18-11-19-00-28-011.00 and legally described as Lot 10 and a portion of Lot 11 in Prairie Lakes Planned Development, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, meeting in regular session, as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of the Bank One Development Plan for Lot 10 and portion of Lot 11 in Prairie Lakes Planned Development are amended to adopt the attached "Exhibit A" as the building base landscaping plan including five (5) trees and sixty-three (63) shrubs.






PLANTING NOTES:

- 1. IN CASE OF DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN THE PLAN AND THE PLANT LIST (IF SHOWN), THE PLAN SHALL DICTATE.
- 2. ALL SHRUB PLANTING AREAS TO BE COVERED W/ 3" LAYER OF SHREDDED HARDWOOD BARK MULCH. ALL GROUND COVER BEDS SHALL BE COVERED W/ 2" SHREDDED HARDWOOD BARK MULCH. MULCH SHALL BE APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND SHALL BE UNIFORM IN TEXTURE AND COLOR AND SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM SAWMILL DO LLUMBERING OPERATION. NO UTILITY MULCH OR PROCESSED TREE TRIMMINGS WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 3. AN APPROVED PRE-EMERGENT HERRICIDE SHALL BE APPLIED IN ALL PLANTING BEDS AT A RATE SPECIFIED BY MANUFACTURER FOR EACH PLANT VARIETY.
- 4. FINAL PLACEMENT OF PLANT MATERIALS, ETC. BE APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT BEFORE PLANTING OPERATIONS ARE TO PROCEED. ALL TREE LOCATIONS SHALL BE MARKED WITH A WOOD STAKE INDICATING VARIETY AND SIZE OF TREE. ALL GROUND COVER AND PLANTING BED LINES SHALL BE MARKED W/ HIGHLY VISIBLE PAINT LINES W/ OCCASIONAL WOOD STAKES FOR REFERENCE, ALL STAKES SHALL BE REMOVED FOLLOWING PLANTING OPERATIONS, LANDSCAPE ASCHIEGT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ADJUST PLANT LOCATIONS ON THE SITE.
- 5. NO SUBSTITUTIONS OF PLANT MATERIALS WILL BE ALLOWED. IF PLANTS ARE NOT AVAILABLE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IN PLANTS ARE NO AVAILABLE, THE CONTINUE TO SHALL NOTIFY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO BID IN WRITHING. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND TAGGED WITH PROJECT LO. AT NURSERY FOR CONTRACTORS OPERATIONS PRIOR TO MOVING TO JOB SITE. PLANTS MAY BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED OR REJECTED ON THE JOB SITE BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- 6. ALL PLANTS SHALL WEFT OR EXCEED AMERICAN STANDARDS FOR NURSERY STOCK, 1996 EDITION, AS SET FORTH BY AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERYMEN.
- 7. PLANTS AND ALL OTHER MATERIALS TO BE STORED ON SITE WILL BE PLACED WHERE THEY WILL NOT CONFLICT W/CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS AND AS DIRECTED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- B. ALL LANDSCAPE PLANTINGS SHALL BE GUARANTEED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FOLLOWING FINAL INSPECTION BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. AT THE END OF THIS PERIOD. PLANT MATERIAL TERMED DEAD OR UNSATISFACTORY BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT SHALL BE REPLACED AT NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE BY THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR.
- 9. LAWNS SHALL BE SODDED FOLLOWING SCARIFYING, FINAL GRADING, FERTILIZING, AND RAKING. LAWN SHALL BE FERTILIZED W/ 12-12-12 ANALYSIS FERT. AT A RATE OF 10lbs_/1000s.f. AND LIME APPLIED AS DICTATED BY SOILS TEST PRIOR TO SODDING.
- ALL PERMITS AND FEES THAT MAY BE REQUIRED FOR HIS PORTION OF WORK. 11. PEATMOSS TO BE USED ON PROJECT SHALL BE DOMESTIC OR IMPORTED MATERIAL CHOCOLATE BROWN IN COLOR AND

COMPOSED OF PARTIALLY DECOMPOSED VEGETABLE







