Re: Long Term Control Plan, Phase IV Project

The City of Noblesville Utilities Department will be starting on a sewer separation project approximately mid-April. The scope of this project is to remove storm water from combination sewers in your neighborhood. As part of this project the storm water will flow into a newly installed storm sewer system and out to the receiving streams. Currently the existing storm water mixes with sanitary sewage and flows to the treatment plant or through Combined Sewer Overflows (CSO) and goes directly into rivers and streams.

Prior to our project starting, Indiana American Water and Vectren have been relocating their utility lines to make way for the new storm sewer system installation. They may have already been working in your area if their lines were in conflict with the new storm sewer.

In most of the construction area it will be necessary for you to park at the rear of your property, or down the street so the construction machinery and trucks have room to maneuver in the specified areas.
